Cmmunauta



Communauto is a company with a social, urban and environmental mission that provides service to 25,000 subscribers by giving them access to over 1,150 self-service vehicles, accessible 24/7. These vehicles, available to be rented for periods of a half-hour, hour, day or longer, can be found in 375 stations located in Quebec, Levis, Gatineau, Sherbrooke, Montreal, Longueil, Saint-Lambert, Laval and Saint-Bruno.

Carsharing, also known as the **self-service car**, is a mobility service which is **complementary** to traditional transportation modes. To use it, you must subscribe to a **membership package**, giving you access to the mobility that a car can provide **without actually having to own one.**

Key facts

- Founded in 1994, Communauto is **the oldest carsharing service in North America** and represents 50% of the Canadian market
- Membership growing at +25 % per year
- A satisfied (94 95%) and loyal clientele
- The use of self-service vehicles can lead to a significantly reduced need and demand for parking spaces in areas which are served.*
- The use of self-service vehicles can lead to a reduction of kilometres driven of, on average, 35% per person per year. *
- The potential market for carsharing in Quebec has been estimated, based on the socioeconomic characteristics of current Communauto subscribers, at around 139,000 adherents. *

Why self-service electric vehicles?

- The **types of trips** taken by carsharing users generally have **short durations and distances** and are therefore well-suited to electric technology. In fact, of the 50,000 trips taken each month by Communauto members, 50% are less than three hours and 25 km.
- A system of self-service vehicles would **make electric vehicles available** to a majority of urban residents living in **densely populated areas of the city,** where it would normally be difficult to provide a recharging network in close proximity to residences.
- This technology will help support and further advance the social, environmental and urban missions of carsharing.
